Contents 500 ml Reagent A100 (lysis buffer).

Reagent A100 is an acidic aqueous solution of surfactant and inorganic acid. The pH

value is in the range of 1.00-1.50.

Application Reagent A100 is used for preparation of nuclei from animal cell cultures and for

detaching adherent cell lines and disaggregation of cell clusters. Please refer to the

specific Application Notes for detailed instructions.

Principle Reagent A100 permeabilizes the plasma membrane, allowing homogenous staining of

the nucleus by DNA-binding dyes such as propidium iodide or DAPI. Reagent A100 is

used in combination with the stabilizing buffer Reagent B (Cat. #: 910-0002).

Use The solution is for research use only (RUO) and is not for diagnostic or therapeutic use.

Store at room temperature, and not in direct sunlight.

Stability Unopened bottles can be stored until the expiry date indicated on the bottle. The lysis

buffer is produced 18 months prior to the expiry date.

Safety information
